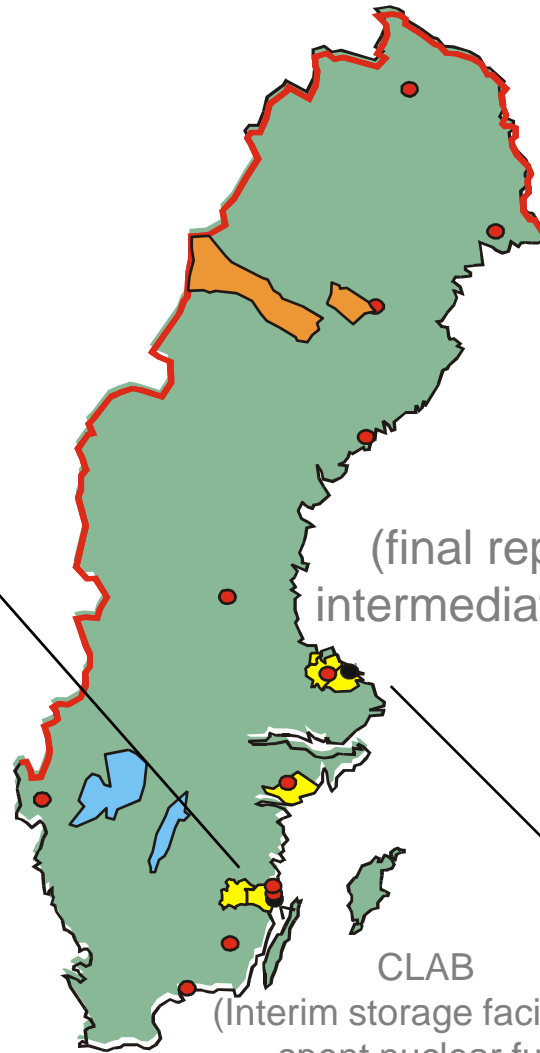

SKB choice of Forsmark, Östhammar to be the site for application for final repository for nuclear high level waste.

The work and preparation for "Added values" starts in the two municipalities.

Added value – a way forward

Two municipalities working in close collaboration to solve a national problem

A comprehensive work during 15 years

The local trust in the process is a prerequisite for success

The project shall contribute to the development of the municipalities

Both municipalities must gain from the process

Added value – a way forward cont.

2 billion SEK (≈200 M €)

75 % to the municipality *not* chosen

Development in different areas

New jobs

Education

Support establishment of companies

Infrastructure

Added value – a way forward cont.

- Jobs and growth
- Level of education increases
- No compensation, only added value
- Östhammar and Oskarshamn signed a formal agreement

Added value – a way forward cont.

- O & Ö made it clear that a successful local process demanded an agreement on added values
- SKB and its owners signed a reciprocal agreement with O & Ö called “The Added Value Program” (AVP).

Added value – The agreement.

- SKB and its shareholders shall create added values for as much as 2 billion SEK 200 (M Euro)
- 25 % to the municipality hosting the final repository and 75% for the other municipality.
- A precondition is a granted construction permit
- Supports a sound foundation for business and industry in the municipalities.
- The projects in AVP must be of a win/win character

Added value – The agreement cont.

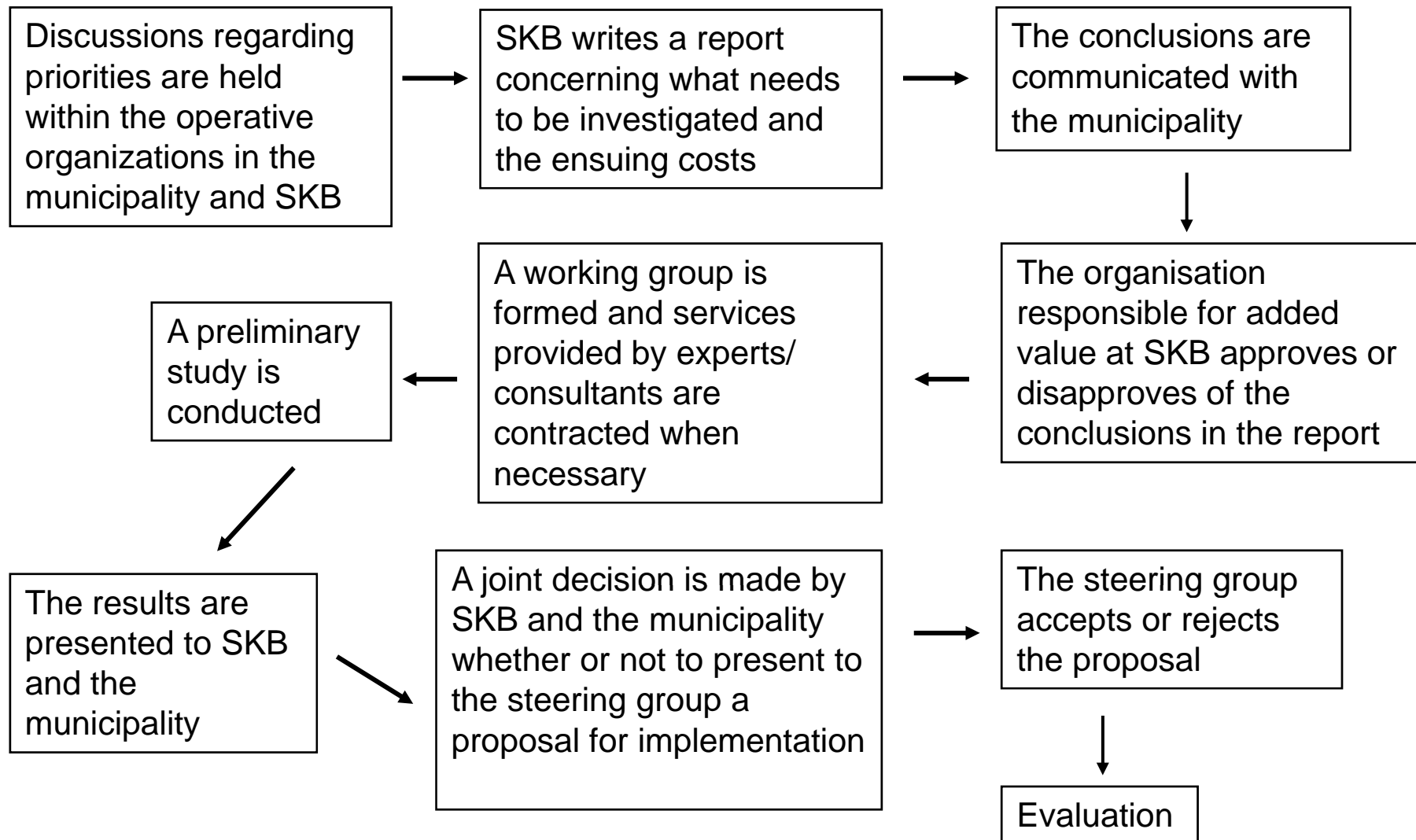
- Two periods:
 - I. 2010-2015 (300 – 400 MSEK)
 - II. 2016 onwards (1600 MSEK)
- The financing of the added values comes from SKB's owners, e.g. Vattenfall, E.ON, Fortum and others.

Added value – The agreement cont.

Areas covered by the added value program:

- Education
- Spin-off / support for innovation systems
- Business development
- Infrastructure
- Visit/information site
- Broadening and diversification of the labor market
- Investments in the energy sector
- Head office functions
- Further development of SKB's laboratories (Oskarshamn)
- Canister manufacturing plant
- Annual compensation to the municipalities
